

The Promise of CPOE

- Some studies show gains
- In practice, very little utility due to "alert fatigue"
 - "I never look at them"
 - "I just click right through them"
 - "Can you turn them off?"
- There are proponents now of only showing potentially lethal interactions



The Promise of CDS

- Strict biologic norms utilized no clinical judgment
- "One dimensional" nature
- Pull modality instead of "push"



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


